April 15, 2010	In executive session, the Board will review the qualifications of the applicants and, in open session, select the candidates to be interviewed.
April 22, 2010	Interview of candidates in a Special Board meeting open to the public, followed by executive session to consider the qualifications of the candidates. The Board anticipates taking final action on selection of a candidate in open session.
May 6, 2010	First meeting and Oath of Office of selected candidate.
